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EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The Euro-Arab Teachers' Network of Refugee and Migrant Education accessible at https://rcecrete-euroarabnet.eu/ has been established to further promote and sustain the project activities and its objectives. Students with a refugee or migrant background often face the same difficulties in adjusting to a new learning environment. Thus, we have decided to cover also migrant education. Through our network, education, and training practitioners can benefit from guidance and the sharing of good practices to be able to address the learning needs of students in increasingly diverse and multilingual classrooms. It is worth pointing out that the European Commission encourages efforts to integrate migrants besides refugees into the host countries' education and training systems - from early childhood education and care to higher education.

Besides the founding members (the RefTeCp Consortium), the Euro-Arab Teachers' Network of Refugee and Migrant Education welcomes associate members from the region and Europe. Currently, four external organisations have established cooperation and another six are in the process of discussion. Below, we present the structure, vision, aims, guiding values, and focus areas.

The Executive Board of the Euro-Arab Teachers' Network for Refugee & Migrant Education is the managerial body of the Network. It is composed of five members for a mandate of four years. It is responsible for ensuring the strength, growth, and sustainability of the Network and is subject to RCE Crete, which is responsible for the maintenance of the Network.

Establishing a teacher professional development network for refugee and migrant education is especially important, as it helps educators acquire new teaching strategies, share good practices and advocate for an inclusive and quality education for all. To this end, currently, we have announced a call for a series of Webinars under the theme of Critical Conversations on Refugee and Migrant Children's Accessibility and Integration in Schools.

In particular, the Euro-Arab Network on Refugee & Migrant Education will be hosting a series of online conversations about issues concerning the integration of refugee and migrant children in schools. The special focus will be on the following countries: Cyprus, Egypt, Greece, Jordan, Italy, Lebanon, and Turkey.
